

#### **Bulletin 1**

The <u>Thai Extreme Sports Association</u> will host the <u>2019 Singha IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships</u> at <u>TE Wake N Ski</u>, Pathum Thani, Thailand, from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> September 2019 having hosted the Asian Beach Games in 2014 and 2015 IWWF Asian Championships.

<u>TE Wake N Ski</u>, opened in 2004, is in its 15th year of operation. There are 3 lakes plus a river location with 4 slalom courses, one ski jump, four ski boats, 2 wake boats. Located in both the Pathum Thani and Ayutthaya Province, one hour North of central Bangkok, TE Wake N Ski offers waterskiing, wakeboarding, wakesurfing and every other towed watersport.



The average temperature in September is between 24°C to 31°C.

## 3. Entry Conditions & Administration

Only paid-up member federations of IWWF Asia are qualified to participate in the 2019 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships. All athletes must be entered by their respective Federations, including individual athletes.

**a. Intention to Enter:** Each federation shall submit to the organizing committee and to the Secretary General of IWWF Asia, not later than 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019 its intent to compete. Any federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete unless they pay a penalty of US\$5.00 per day to the organizer. Each federation shall submit to the organizing committee and to the Secretary General of IWWF Asia, not later than thirty (30) days before







the scheduled start of the first event of the 2019 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships, the names of the members of its team, the disciplines (Waterski, Wakeboard & Wakesurf), the events each will enter, the ranking of each skier/rider, as well as the names of the official reserves. Any federation not meeting this requirement may not be allowed to compete, or if so allowed at the discretion of the Chief Judges and the organizing committee until the federation pays a penalty of US\$1.00 per day after the 30 (thirty) day deadline to the organizer for each skier/rider not officially entered. If the official entry forms are not received 24 hours prior to the start of the first event, the federation's skiers' and riders' places in the draw, if allowed to participate, shall be determined by the respective Chief Judges without reference to their ranking.

#### 4A. TOURNAMENT TEAM OVERALL COMPETITION - ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION

As per the 2019 IWWF Asian Tournament Rules, there will be three (3) separate team **AWARDS** for Open, Masters and U17. For Open, the best <u>three</u> (3) scores, men **AND** women, in eliminations or finals shall be summed up to obtain the team score. For Masters and U17, the best <u>two</u> (2) scores, men **AND** women, in eliminations or finals shall be summed up to obtain the team score. At least one (1) score for each sex is to be used.

The Max Kirwan Shield will be awarded to the team with the highest overall combined team score of these three separate events.
