Updated/New Information In Green

The [Thailand Extreme Sports Association \(TESA\)](#) will host the [2025 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships](#) in Bangkok, Thailand from 24<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> June 2025. Thailand is no stranger to hosting regional international events having also organised the Asian Beach Games in 2014 and 2015 & 2019 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships

The official arrival dates are from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> June 2025, depending on the discipline and departure date is Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025. Teams are kindly requested to schedule their departures from Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 onwards so they can attend the Team Overall Awards Presentation & Closing Ceremony Dinner on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2025. There will be no rescheduling of the Awards Ceremony to accommodate early departures.

The average temperature in June is between 25°C to 37°C.



### 3. Event Venue

[Rabbit Lake](#), in Minburi, where it hosted the IWWF Asian Championships 10 years ago in 2015, and is located 41 km / 50 minute drive from Bangkok, 33 km / 38 minute drive from [Suvarnabhumi Airport \(BKK\)](#) and 32 km / 30 minute drive from [Don Mueang International Airport \(DMK\)](#).



#### 4. Entry Conditions & Administration

Only paid-up member federations of IWWF Asia are qualified to participate in the 2025 IWWF Asian Waterski & Wakesports Championships. All athletes must be entered by their respective Federations, including individual athletes.

##### a. Entry Fee

Entry fee for each athlete will be **USD250.00 per sport discipline**, ie. USD250.00 to enter waterskiing (slalom, trick and/or jump), USD250.00 to enter wakeboard and USD250.00 to enter wakesurf.

This includes the following for athletes, one team official (two team officials for teams of 4 or more athletes) and Federation representatives (President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer):

- (i) Airport transfers 21<sup>st</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> June
- (ii) Venue transfers 24<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> June
- (iii) Lunch on Competition Days
- (iv) Opening Ceremony Dinner
- (v) Closing Ceremony Dinner

However, if one athlete intends to participate in a crossover discipline, USD100.00 will be charged for the second discipline, ie. athlete enters waterskiing and wakeboard = USD350.00 Entry fee, athlete enters wake skim and wake surf = USD350.00 Entry fee.

Entry fees must be paid by bank transfer no later than **24<sup>th</sup> May 2025**. The Entry Fee also includes a levy of USD30.00 to assist towards the travel costs of Technical Officials. Currency is in US Dollars.

##### b. IWWF's Event Management System (EMS)

IWWF's [Event Management System \(EMS\)](#) will be used to enter all athletes to compete. Please ensure your federation/ association is enrolled in this system and your athletes are registered accordingly.

##### c. Intention to Enter

Each federation shall submit to the organizing committee and to the Secretary General of IWWF Asia, not later than **24<sup>th</sup> March 2025** its intent to compete (click [here](#) for the intention to enter form). Each federation shall submit to the organizing committee and to the Secretary General of IWWF Asia, not later than **24<sup>th</sup> May 2025**, the names of the members of its team,



the disciplines (Waterski, Wakeboard & Wakesurf), the events each will enter, the ranking of each skier/rider, as well as the names of the official reserves. Any federation not meeting this requirement may not be allowed to compete, or if so allowed at the discretion of the Chief Judges and the organizing committee until the federation pays a penalty of US\$1.00 per day after the **24<sup>th</sup> May 2025 deadline** to the organizer for each skier/rider not officially entered. If the official entry forms are not received 24 hours prior to the start of the first event, the federation's skiers' and riders' places in the draw, if allowed to participate, shall be determined by the respective Chief Judges without reference to their ranking.

#### d. Entry of Athletes in EMS

Each Federation must enter its skiers and riders through the IWWF Event Management System (EMS) not later than 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025 deadline. Penalties may be imposed for late registration. **An entry is considered complete when the Skier's/Rider's name is registered in EMS and the full Entry Fee Payment has been received.** For 2025 the entry fee payment cannot be made through EMS and must follow the process described in this Information Bulletin Clause 7 below.

As far as possible the events that each skier/rider will participate in, including their chosen ramp ratio, will be completed in EMS. Official reserves should also be listed. There is no limit on the number of official reserves for each team. A reserve must pay the entry fee and may ski or ride and medal, but their result will not count in the team awards. The team members must be nominated no later than upon registration on arrival in Bangkok.

Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine to the organiser of US\$1 per skier/rider per day after 15<sup>th</sup> May 2025 deadline, for each skier not officially entered. After the 15<sup>th</sup> May deadline a Federation may enter up to two more athletes than originally entered with no penalty, and for which the full entry fee is required as stated above. If more than two additional athletes are added after the 15<sup>th</sup> of July deadline a supplement of US\$50 per additional athlete will be applied. Any name changes or event entered may be changed without penalty up to the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2025. The registration of the Athletes is to be done by a Federation EMS Administrator as follows:

1. The EMS Federation Administrator has to login to EMS
2. Go to the Competitions menu and set:
  - Code "[25ASIA01](#)" for Wakeboard and the Country "Thailand" in the Search Filters
  - Code "[25ASIA02](#)" for Wakesurf and the Country "Thailand" in the Search Filters
  - Code "[25ASIA03](#)" for Waterski and the Country "Thailand" in the Search Filters
3. Select the appropriate competition from the list
4. Scroll down to the Participations section and click the "New participation" button to register the Athletes
5. Enter the Name of the Athlete in the Search box and click on the loop sign to the right
6. Register the *Category in Competition*, the *Event* " and the *Entry Type*
7. Click on the blue "+Add" button and the participant will be registered
8. Repeat the steps 5 to 7 for any additional participants

## e. IWWF License

Following an agreement by the IWWF World Congress held in 2019, the IWWF Executive Board approved the establishment of an IWWF License fee from 2021 where athletes wishing to compete in Ranking List / 1 to 6 Star competitions (including IWWF World titled events) in each Sports Division of the IWWF are required to hold an IWWF License. It is requested that Federations ensure that all their athletes hold a valid IWWF License in order to participate in the 2025 IWWF Asian Championships.

## 5. Official Familiarisation - optional

Each athlete will only be allocated (1) one Official Familiarization slot. Time slots will be given on a first-come first-served, paid basis, only. **Time slots will only be confirmed when payment is received by TESA.** The Official Familiarization schedule will be subject to the number of athletes and will be posted by the Organizers no later than 5 days before the beginning of the event.

## 6. Summarised Rules - General

The competition will be conducted according to the IWWF Asian Technical Rules for Waterski, Wakeboard and Wakesurf. The following serves to summarize tournament and wakeboard rules. If there are any contradictions, the 2025 IWWF Asian Waterski, Wakeboard and Wakesurf Rules will apply.

#### 6A. TOURNAMENT TEAM OVERALL COMPETITION – ADDITIONAL EXPLANATION

As per the 2022 IWWF Asian Tournament Rules, there will be four (4) separate team **AWARDS** for Open, Masters+35, Masters+45 and U17. For Open, the best three (3) scores, men **AND** women, in eliminations or finals shall be summed up to obtain the team score. For Masters+35, Masters +45 and U17, the best two (2) scores, men **AND** women, in eliminations or finals shall be summed up to obtain the team score. At least one (1) score for each sex is to be used. The Max Kirwan Shield will be awarded to the team with the highest overall combined team score of these three separate events Open, Junior(U17) and Masters+45.

#### **6C. Wakesurf Team Overall Competition – Additional Explanation**

There will be three (3) separate team AWARDS for Open, Juniors and Masters Wakesurf. The Thomas Lin Wakesurf Team Overall Shield will be awarded to the team with the highest overall COMBINED team score of both Open, Junior and Masters.

All competitors take part at their own risk in every respect even if they are engaged out of the competition, e.g. in any additional program. With their entry in the competition, they give up any claim for instances of loss of any kind arising indirectly or directly during this event.

## 11. Insurance

The IWWF Bye-Law 16.1 states:

It is the responsibility of each Federation when entering competitors to ensure that its competitors are adequately insured for personal accident, permanent disabilities, death and medical expenses. The athletes should take out private accident insurance besides their health insurance. Damage to third parties (e.g. spectators) is insured only within the limits of the organizer's liability. Participants will be required to sign a waiver upon registering **and provide evidence of adequate personal accident insurance.**


